HISTORY

- ❖ Vignobles Lesgourgues did the resumption of the tenant farm of this estate to the Château Fieuzal in 1997.
- ❖ The wines from this terroir are known for their great reputation: they are among the favourite Graves for the natives people from Bordeaux.

VINEYARD

- ❖ 3 hectares dedicated to white grapes on the total of 25 hectares
- ❖ Production : 15 000 bottles
- ❖ Average age : 35ans
- ❖ Siliceous graves and clayey graves on a calcareous ground

BLENDING

- ❖ 34 % Sauvignon
- ❖ 66% Sémillon

VINIFICATION

- ❖ Prefermentary skin maceration
- ❖ Ageing: 6 months, in oak barrels
